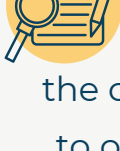


## Letter From The President Nancy Grahlmann

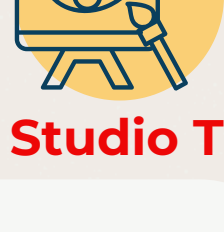

## The Who, What, Where, When, and Why of the Tour d' Artistes Studio Tour

### How the Studio Tour Got Started, how we are helping our schools.

Michele Williams, a former member of the Art League started the Studio Tour as a fundraiser so the League could support the local school art teachers. Over the years of the tour, teachers have been provided funds, though various methods, to support art in our local schools. Currently, we are asking teachers, (Art and Classroom teachers) to complete a grant form which is handled by Gretchen Boyer. In 2024, we supported a fused glass project in the high school and an architecture/design project in the Middle School with \$1800 in total grants. The tour is held each year on the first full weekend in March. Many discussions have occurred over the years to settle the question of when is the best time for the tour. Participants are asked to sign up for tasks to help with the behind the scenes work to make the tour happen. Those who participate in helping, get a discount on their registration after the tour. Registration for the tour starts in August, when the form is posted on the Art League website. Entries are due by mid-October. Artists are asked to ask local businesses to sponsor the tour, with instructions and paperwork provided. All Art League members are invited to assist in procuring sponsors. The deadline for turning the sponsor sign ups is mid-November so the brochure draft can be prepared for proofreading by the participating artists by mid-December. Brochures are available in January.

Press releases are sent to a long list of publications in November and December. In January and February the signage and advertising teams are busy with their tasks in preparation for the tour. We are encouraging the use of Social Media platforms, as our society moves in that direction for news and information. It is a continuous, work in progress which all tour participants are requested to engage in throughout the year to get the word out about participating in and visiting the tour.

Most of the studios are looking for volunteers to greet the guests on their studio visits. We invite Art League members and friends to volunteer for a morning or afternoon shift of welcoming the Tour attendees at a studio.

## All Member Show

**Intake for the All Member Show artwork is on Monday, February 3, from 10:30 to 12:00 noon at the Fountain Hills Community Center.** You may enter up to 2 pieces of art. Please try to have your paperwork completed to speed up the intake. We need 2 Hold Harmless forms, one for the Community Center and one for the Art League. Plus, each piece must have a label taped to the back of the art (or attached somehow). I will have forms at the intake if you were unable to submit your online application. Remember we need a wire on the back of any art for hanging, alligator hangers do not work with the hanging apparatus at the Community Center.

The winners of this show will be chosen by the public. We will have ballots available in the hallway for the community to pick their favorite piece. We will announce the two winners, the People's Choice Award and an Honorable Mention Award at the public reception held on Wednesday, February 19th from 4:00 pm until 6:00 pm at the Community Center. The winner of this show is eligible to participate in the December Artist of the Year competition. 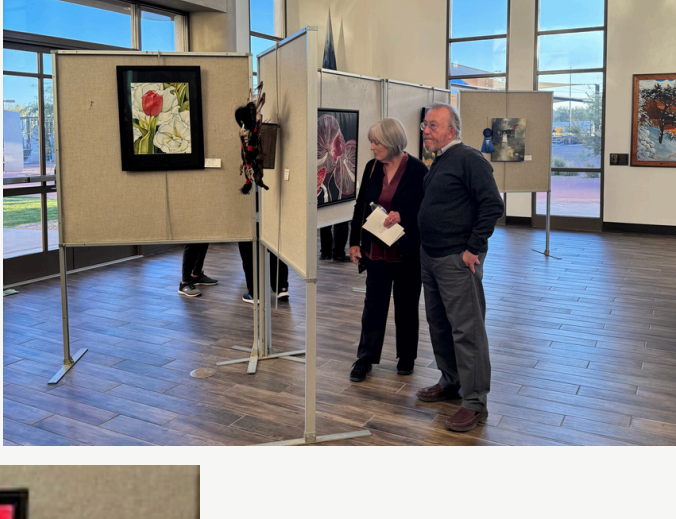
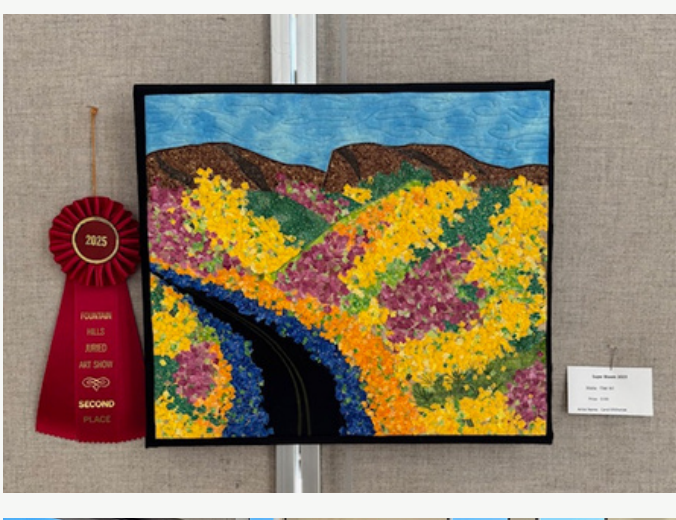
