Veronique explained that Atticus Book is interested in being a host location hosting their employee, Carmen Kern, whose art is book binding. Veronique will clarify whether their intent is to sponsor and host or host without being a sponsor. We value having a new art form represented and are hopeful we can agree on a favorable arrangement for this year's tour.

Spooner Physical Therapy is a sponsor for the 2026 tour. An art league member has informed the board that she told Spooner's owner they could host one or two artists, that we would consider flying our banner on their building, and that they do not need to provide a digital copy of their logo for our publications. These decisions are the responsibility of the tour director to assure any agreement is suitable to the needs of the art league. Veronique will be meeting with the owner of Spooner Physical Therapy tomorrow to clarify the issues.

The group discussed options for placement of two artists who do not have a confirmed host location. This will be resolved within the week.

Kim said there are a few past sponsors for whom she does not have a final decision for the 2026 tour. Her goal is to clarify yes/no for all prior sponsors. She can then compile a list of confirmed sponsors for 2026; she will retain a separate list of past sponsors. Likewise she will compile a list of host locations for future reference.

All donors of raffle items will be asked to bring those items to either the December or January all member meeting. The goal is to display all raffle gifts during the tour either at a central location or spread throughout the host locations. This will allow tour attendees to see the raffle prizes prior to the drawing.

There will be a meeting of tour artists tonight, November 17, from 5-6PM at the Chamber of Commerce. Participating artists have had prior notification of this meeting as well as any other informational meetings.
